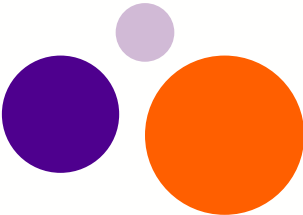

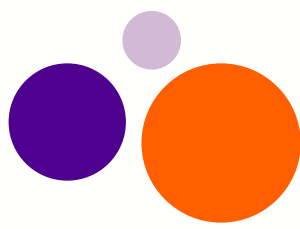

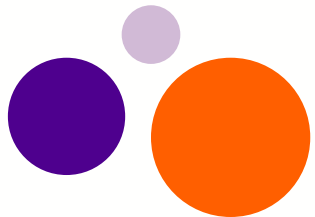
Renee Jones, OTR/L
